DUTIES: Under supervision, conducts research involving data collection and analysis, develops and implements policy, and administers social services programs. Conducts patient/client/consumer intakes, participates in treatment team planning, and performs crisis intervention. Assists in dealing with personal and social problems. May provide supportive counseling to consumers and families and/or serve as a liaison for social services. May perform case management duties. Actively link and guide clients with information and strategies on how to access HIV/AIDS treatment and support services. Other duties in relation to this overarching objective are: Assist clinic staff in linking clients to resources identified related to health insurance enrollment, financial assistance, medication, home care, transportation and other social services. Identify and support clients and other health center staff in addressing client barriers to care. Follow-up with clients who miss appointments for HIV/AIDS medical and support services. Provide basic HIV/AIDS education and education resources to newly diagnosed clients. Offer emotional support and make referrals to support groups and classes.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Bachelor's degree in a related field from an accredited college or university

Four years of related experience.
