

As Soon As You Decide to Travel

Schedule an appointment at one of our travel clinics. Be sure to call at least four weeks before your trip.

If necessary:

- Call for a last-minute appointment. We will strive to serve you.
- Ask for an interpreter to assist during your appointment. Interpretation in many languages is available.

For Your Appointment

Bring:

- Your immunization record.
- The list of medications you're taking.

To speed up your visit, go to dekalbpublichealth.com and click on Services and then Travel Medicine. Complete and bring the travel itinerary and patient history forms.



During Your Appointment

First, the nurse will:

- Ask about your travel plans (destination, length of stay, lodging, activities, etc.).
- Review your immunization record, list of medications and history form.

Next, the nurse will:

- Explain the current health risks associated with your destination.
- Review your destination's required and recommended immunizations.
- Provide immunizations.
- Advise you on staying healthy while traveling.

Finally, the nurse will:

- Give you an International Certificate of Vaccination or Prophylaxis (the World Health Organization's "yellow card").
- Provide a prescription slip, if needed, to prevent malaria or altitude sickness or to treat traveler's diarrhea.
- Schedule any follow-up visits that may be necessary.
