- Develops, implements, and modifies plans of care based on assessment findings.
- Provides treatments, medications, immunizations, and other nursing interventions in accordance with established protocols.
- Delivers preventive health, maintenance care, and health promotion services.
- Provides health education and counseling to individuals and families.
- Screens clients and coordinates referrals to healthcare providers, specialists, and community resources.
- Participates in care coordination and case management activities.
- Maintains accurate clinical documentation, reports, and records.
- Participates in planning, implementation, and evaluation of public health programs and services.
- Collaborates with multidisciplinary teams and community partners.
- Participates in emergency preparedness, disaster response, and public health emergency activities.
- Conducts outreach activities, home visits, chart reviews, or follow-up activities as assigned.
- Cross-trains in various public health programs and services.
- Performs job responsibilities with minimal supervision.
- Performs other duties as assigned

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:** Bachelor's degree in nursing from an accredited college or university AND current Georgia license to practice as a Registered Professional Nurse AND CPR certification

OR

Associate's degree in nursing from an accredited college or university AND One year of nursing experience AND completion of a PHN course within one year of hire AND current Georgia Registered Professional Nurse license AND CPR certification.
